## Knowledge – What I will know at the end of the unit.

**Sing:** To confidently sing songs and rap from memory and sing them in unison.

**Play:** To know the names of the notes in an instrumental part from memory or when written down.

**Improvise:** To know that when someone improvises, they make up their own tune that has never been heard before. It is not written down and belongs to them.

**Compose:** To know that everyone can compose.

**Perform:** To know that a performance is sharing music with other people, called an audience



#### **Activities**

Revisit several activities from across the year including:

- Listening to and appraising previously learned songs.
- · Singing previously learned songs.
- Playing previously performed pieces
- Reviewing musical notation learned throughout the year

### Vocabulary

- Classical music written in the late 18<sup>th</sup> Century.
- Crotchet musical note that means 1 beat.



- Reflect think back and discuss
- Replay play again
- **Rewind** wind backwards to the beginning.
- **Semibreve** musical note that means four beats



#### Skills

- **Sing:** Start and stop singing when following a leader.
- Play: Learn to play an instrumental part that matches their musical challenge.
- Improvise: Take it in turns to improvise using one or two notes.
- **Compose:** Write down the notes of the composition.
- Perform: Choose a song you have learnt from the Scheme and perform it.
