Lightning appears as a bright flash or streak of light in the sky. • Rain - drops of water that form in the clouds and fall from the sky • Season - one of 4 divisions of the year often marked by different weather patterns. • Snow - soft, white flakes of ice that fall from the sky to the earth. Snow is formed when water in the upper air freezes into crystals. • Storm - a violent disturbance in the atmosphere that brings rain, snow, wind, thunder, or lightning. • Sun - a spinning ball of hot, glowing gas that provides heat and light to all the planets in the solar system, including Earth. • Temperature - how hot or cold something is. • Thunder - the loud cracking noise or low distant rumble that follows a flash of lightning. • Wind - the movement of air as it moves over the surface of the Earth.
