Knowledge

Exodus is the Bible story of the journey of Moses where he led all of the Israelites out of Egypt, across the Red Sea, to freedom in the wilderness.

- Judaism religion based on belief in one God and on the laws contained in the Torah and Talmud
- Moses the most important Jewish Prophet who is also a prophet for other religions
- Torah the first 5 books of the Jewish special text
