# Knowledge – What I will know at the end of the unit.

**Sing:** Know that songs include other ways of using the voice e.g. rapping (spoken word).

**Play:** Know the names of un-tuned percussion instruments played in class

**Improvise:** Know that improvisation is making up your own tunes on the spot.

**Compose:** Know that composing is like writing a story with music.

**Perform:** Know that performance is sharing music with others.



#### Activities

- Find the pulse!
  - You can be rapper and find the pulse
- Clapping Rhythms
  - Clap the rhythm of your name
  - Clap the rhythm of your favourite colour
  - Make up your own rhythm
- Singing
  - Rap and sing Ho Ho
     Ho.
- Improvise
  - Rapping using words
- Playing Instruments
  - Using up to three notes – G or G, A and B.
- Perform
  - Class performance of Ho Ho Ho!

### Vocabulary

- Audience the people who listen to a performance.
- Bass guitar



- **Composing** creating and developing musical ideas and 'fixing' them.
- **Dynamics** how loudly or quietly the music is being played.
- Improvise to make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.
- Keyboard



- Performing singing and playing instruments for others to hear.
- **Percussion** instruments played by hitting or shaking them.
- **Pitch** a musical dimension that describes the range of high and low sounds.
- Pulse/beat the heartbeat or steady beat of a song/piece of music.
- Rap speaking (not singing) in time to the music.
- Rhythm a musical dimension that describes the combination of long and short sounds to make patterns.
- Saxophone



- Tempo describes how fast or slowly the music is played.
- Trumpet

- **Sing:** Make different types of sounds with your voice you can rap (spoken word with rhythm).
- Play: Listen to and follow musical instructions from a leader.
- Improvise: Listen and clap back an answer
- Compose: Create simple melodies using two notes.
- Perform: Sing songs from memory.
