<p>Anselm Kiefer He is a printer, painter and sculptor who grew up in post WW2 Germany. A common theme in his work is the memories of bombed, broken, ruined buildings that he saw as a child</p> <p>Michelangelo 1475-1564 Considered to be one of the greatest artists of all time, he was a sculptor, painter, architect, poet and engineer. His most famous works are the paintings on the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican.</p> <p>Le Corbusier 1887-1967 He was an architect, furniture designer and painter. He designed buildings because he thought it was important to build better places for people in crowded cities to live</p> <p>Salvador Dali 1904-1989 A Spanish painter, designer, sculptor and filmmaker. He was a surrealist artist. The items in his pictures had hidden meanings e.g. ants meant death.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Coco Chanel 1883-1971 French fashion designer famous for making simple, easy to wear clothes for women. Her first shop sold hats she had decorated herself.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Hat by Chanel</p> </div>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Architect – a person who designs buildings • Architecture – the art of designing buildings • Renaissance architecture – the European architectural style of the early 14th to 16th centuries that was based on the symmetry and shapes of ancient Greece and Rome • Fresco – a painting in watercolour on a wall or ceiling. Because the plaster is wet, the paint spreads easily and becomes permanent when it is dry
