Frida Kahlo 1907-1954 Married to Diego Rivera. She was a Mexican artist famous for her self-portraits and for painting women as strong people. She used bright colours. Joaquin Torres Garcia 1874-1949 He made toys, paintings and sculptures. He preferred earthy colours and used symbols from music, religion, horoscopes, traffic, technology and ancient cultures. He was influenced by the artist Mondrian. Leonora Carrington 1917-2011 A British born artist who lived in Mexico, she painted dream- like images using fantasy characters. Her love of nursery rhymes and fairy tales can be seen in her work. Diego Rivera 1886-1957 Married to Frida Kahlo. A Mexican painter, he was famous for creating huge murals because he wanted ordinary people to see his work. His style was big, bold and colourful, often with a political message attacking the ruling classes. Beatriz Milhazes A Brazilian collage artist and painter who uses very colourful materials, she is influenced by the tropical plants and flowers and the carnivals in her culture.
